

The "fish-amphibian" transition:

-From *On Pandas and People*:

"If crossopterygians really did evolve into amphibians tremendous change must have taken place.

- Fins must have transformed into forelimbs
- The skull had to change from two parts to a single solid piece.
- The hip bones had to enlarge and become attached to the backbone...
- (and additionally) the air bladder of the fish must have been transformed into the lungs of the amphibian."

"How many different transitional species were required to bridge (this) gap...we don't know, but we do know that no such transitional species have been recovered."
